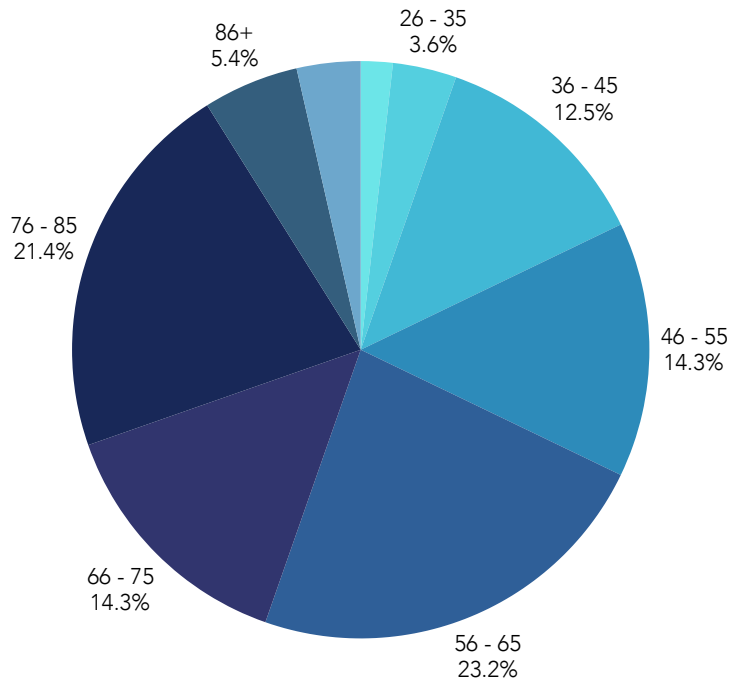

- 93% of involvement comes from tenants.

- 3.5% are leaseholders.

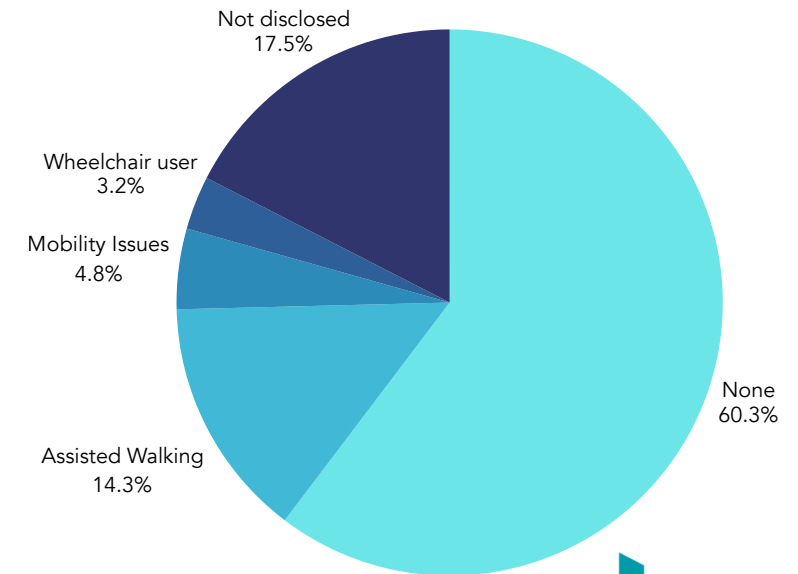
- 73% of involved tenants have no sensory disability.
- 12% have a hearing impairment.
- 5% have a visual impairment.
- 10% did not disclose.

- 5% of involved tenants disclosed they have a learning disability
- 25% disclosed they have a mental health condition.

AREAS OF REPRESENTATION



We have been looking at where our involved tenants live, highlighting any geographical areas of underrepresentation

- **North East and Dearne - 28% of involved tenants come from this area**
- **South - 20% of involved tenants come from this area**
- **Central - 28% of involved tenants come from this area**
- **North & Penistone - 24% of involved tenants come from this area.**

HOW OUR INVOLVED RESIDENT PROFILE COMPARES TO OUR TENANT PROFILE



The gender profile is similar.



We still need more under 35 year olds actively engaged as 14.5% of our tenants are under 35 compared to 5.4% of involved tenants.



86% of involved tenants are White British, this is the same as the overall tenant profile.



Our involved residents have higher rates of physical disability (25%) compared to our tenants (19%).



Our involved residents have higher rates of sensory disability (16%) than our tenants (13.5%).



The rate of learning disabilities is similar our involved tenants (5%) compared to our tenants (4.9%)



Our involved tenants have similar rates of mental health conditions (27%) compared to our tenants (22.2%).



The largest percentage of involved tenants come from the North East and Dearne and Central areas (28%)
